Frequently Asked Questions

Who is the lecturer and what are her qualifications?

Trevalyne Paul-Tuitt is the CEO and Principal Design Consultant of Professional Interior Designs Limited. Trevalyne Paul-Tuitt is a trained professional interior designer with a Diploma in Interior Design and Space Development from the Sheffield School of Interior Design, New York, USA and is also a member of the American Society of Interior Designers (ASID) and the American Society of Professional Wedding consultants (ASPWC) based in Los Angeles, USA.

Is the program registered and recognized?

Yes, the program is ASID registered and approved.

Is this course registered with any organization or government that offers grants or financial aid?

No, individuals or employers or social organizations privately finance it.

How long has the Interior Design Education Programme been in existence?

The courses were introduced in 1992.

How long are the sessions?

There are 10 sessions held on Saturdays. Sessions are three (3) hours long.

Will my certification be recognized anywhere?

The certification will be ASID certified.

Will I be considered an Interior Designer when I graduate from this program?

No, but you will have a greater sense and appreciation of good design and will be adequately prepared to transform your home and the homes of friends into paradises of designers quality.

Should I have my own home before I attempt this program?

This is not necessary. A great number of lessons are to be learned and understood before the acquisition of a home. However, if you already are a homeowner, this program can be the tool to transform it into your masterpiece.

Do I have to be able to draw or sew and will there be any sewing during the programme?

Absolutely not and there will be no sewing involved.

Are these courses held on a regular basis? When is the next one scheduled?

There are two (2) programs annually. The next course is scheduled for later this year.

Does this certificate entitle me to further myself in any other programs?

Yes, you will be entitled to enroll in our Interior Design Education Programme - Part 2. These courses also serve as pre-requisites for entrance into design school.

Do I need any special qualifications to do this programme?

No special qualifications are necessary to do this programme.

Are there any pre-requisites?

Any interested participant, either male or female, between the ages of 16 to 86 is welcome to participate. The programme is also well-suited for personnel who handle and support the Interior Design Services: painters, cabinetry builders, furniture builders, drapery specialists, tile installers and all other industry support personnel.
